Yes___ No___</p> <p>If you require an annulment, here is the procedure: An annulment must be handled by the Advocate appointed by the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Please call the Tribunal for the proper information and procedure. Tribunal Office Number is (410) 547-5533.</p> <p>Please know this could take many months and requires paperwork. The Advocate is there to assist you. The annulment proceedings may not be able to complete the paperwork by next Easter, which may mean a delay for your reception into the sacramental life of the church. There is no "exact time frame" when the Final Decree will be made, as it depends on many factors, such as getting paper work on time, receiving responses from you former spouse and your chosen witnesses, etc.</p> <p>While awaiting the Final Decree, you are encouraged and welcome to come to Mass, worship and pray with us, and continue to learn about your faith, and grow in holiness through acts of service.</p> <p>Reception of the Sacraments of Initiation will occur once the Final Decree has been received from the Tribunal. If a couple needs to have a current civil marriage "validated" (i.e., blessed and recognized by the Church) by a simple, there is a church ceremony that must be completed prior to the reception of Sacraments of Initiation. This can be arranged with a parish priest or deacon.</p>
