Itinerary

FRIDAY JUNE 23: FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Depart USA via overnight flight on scheduled airline to Tel Aviv, Israel.

SATURDAY JUNE 24: ARRIVE TEL AVIV | SEA OF GALILEE

Arrive in Tel Aviv. After passport control, a BesTouR representative will find you and escort you to the arrival hall where you meet your professional Tour Manager. Board your air-conditioned private motor coach for transfer to the Sea of Galilee, and check into our hotel in Tiberias. After check-in, we will have our opening Mass on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel in Tiberias. (D)

SUNDAY JUNE 25: MOUNT OF BEATITUDES BANIAS | TABGHA | PRIMACY

Drive this morning to the Mount of Beatitudes and celebrate Mass where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. After Mass, continue further north to Banias (Caesarea Philippi) to visit the site where Jesus asked His disciples "Who do people say that I AM?" This afternoon we drive back to the Sea of Galilee to visit the site of the multiplication of loaves and fish. Nearby, we visit the church of the Primacy of Peter where Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and anointed Peter as the head of His Church. Dinner at Magdalena Gourmet Chef Restaurant and overnight in Tiberias. (CB | D)

MONDAY JUNE 26: MOUNT TABOR | CANA | NAZARETH

Drive to the foot of Mount Tabor, where we leave our bus and use smaller mini-vans to take us up to the top of the mountain where Jesus met Moses and Elijah at the Transfiguration. Then travel to the town of Cana in Galilee and visit where Jesus turned water into wine at a wedding feast. Married couples will have a chance to renew their wedding vows! After a lunch break we travel to Nazareth and celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation and visit the Grotto of the Incarnation. Visit the church of St. Joseph built over the House of the Holy Family. Drive back to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Tiberius. (CB | D)

TUESDAY JUNE 27: CAPERNAUM | SEA OF GALILEE | CAESAREA | BETHLEHEM

This morning we check out of our hotel and drive to Capernaum, the headquarters of Jesus' Galilean ministry. There we celebrate Mass on top of the House of Peter. We visit the old Synagogue where Jesus taught the Bread of Life Discourse (John 6). We will also view an ancient boat from the time of Jesus that was found at the shores of Magdala and take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. This afternoon, we drive south towards Jerusalem and stop at Caesarea Maritime to visit the site where St. Peter baptised the Roman centurion Cornelius and where St. Paul was kept a prisoner for two years. Arrive into Jerusalem and check into our hotel in Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight. (CB | D)

WEDNESDAY JUNE 28: BETHLEHEM

This morning we drive to the city of Bethlehem to visit and have Mass at the Shepherds' Field. Following Mass, we will go up to the Church of the Nativity to visit the Basilica and the Grotto of the Nativity underneath, where our Lord was born. We will visit the nearby Church of St. Catherine, where midnight Mass is celebrated every December 25th. Underneath St. Catherine's, we visit the Grotto of St. Joseph and the Grotto of St Jerome, where he translated the Scriptures in the 4th century. Then back to our hotel. (CB | D)

THURSDAY JUNE 29: MOUNT OLIVES | MOUNT ZION

This morning we drive to the Mount of Olives to pray Mass at the Garden of Gethsemane. Then we visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught his disciples how to pray the Our Father. After lunch, we drive to Mt. Zion to visit the Dormition Abbey, where Mary fell asleep and was assumed. We also visit the Upper Room, situated above the place of Last Supper. We end our day with a visit to the church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Drive back to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (CB | D)

FRIDAY JUNE 30: JERUSALEM

Today we get up early to walk the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow), to pray the Stations of the Cross, ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We visit the actual tomb of Christ, and Mt. Calvary. Mass will be in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Back to the hotel for breakfast. Later, visit the Church of St. Anne and the Pools of Bethesda. Stop at the Wailing Wall. Free afternoon for re-visit and shopping. Dinner and overnight. (CB | D)

SATURDAY JULY 01: JORDAN RIVER | QUMRAN | JERICHO | DEAD SEA

Start our day early with a drive to the Jordan River where Our Lord was baptized by John the Baptist. We will have a chance to renew our baptismal vows. Visit Qumran, the site of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Drive into Jericho to view the ancient sycamore and Mt. Temptation. Mass at the Good Shepherd Church in Jericho. Have a chance to float in the Dead Sea before we drive back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (CB | D)

SUNDAY JULY 02: JERUSALEM | ISRAEL MUSEUM | EIN KAREM

This morning we drive to the Israel Museum to visit the model of Jerusalem and describing the city as it was at the time of our Lord. We will also visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept. Later, we go to Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation, where Mary came to visit her kinswoman, Elizabeth. Celebrate Mass, then drive back to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (CB | D). We check out of our hotel and drive to the Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv for our departure flight back to the United States.
